

Vacancy – Social Worker

Molo Songololo, a child rights NGO, seeks an experienced social worker to form part of the Victim Empowerment Program (VEP) focusing of child sexual offences in the Atlantis and surrounding area.

The person must have the following:

- Social Work degree with 3-5 years work experience dealing with statutory intervention, court cases, report writing for court cases, counseling victims of trauma, especially sexual trauma, workshop & facilitation skills
- Registered with Social Service Professional Board
- Proficient in English, Afrikaans (Xhosa is advantageous)
- Good report writing skills and efficient in MS Office
- Driver's license is essential, own transport an advantage
- Knowledge and understanding of new child legal framework and statutory regulations, requirements and schedules

Duties & responsibilities include

- Manage and implement the VEP in Atlantis and surrounding areas
- Receive and follow-up on reported and walk-in cases of child abuse
- Conduct interviews and counseling with child victims and family members
- Conduct initial case assessments, develop case reports and make necessary referrals, follow-up and report to authorities when necessary
- Facilitate for the statutory intervention and liaise with role-players concerning the investigative and prosecutorial process
- Conduct ongoing cases assessments, and update IDPs and do follow-ups
- Implement a counseling, therapeutic and empowerment programme for children which include their families.
- Keep adequate record of all cases, procedures and processes
- Submit regular work reports as prescribed by the Project Manager
